When a soldier deserts from battle, he soon discovers the true cost of war through a young heroic Black man, who teaches him the real meaning of Freedom.

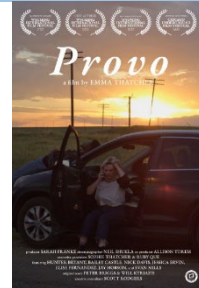
